 Directions: Our club lake is off of Interstate 71. Merge onto US-224 W via EXIT 209 toward Lodi. Turn right onto County Road 19 (Lake Road). The driveway is about 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile on the right (8809 Lake Road). Follow the driveway all the way back around the lake and into the camping area. As you're exiting off of 71, you can see the lake if you look to the NE. Music is the park theme and maybe played until 11:00PM each night.

### Event and Race Rules

- **Note that: US-1 classes are now running in three separate two day groups. S-M, T-W, T-F.**
- **B Sport Tunnel: Will not race for an US-1 title, but will race under the same format as the US-1 Classes for its own National Championship Award. IMPBA rules will apply and be strictly enforced. All entries will be checked before and randomly during the event.**
- The Digital Clock will start for all upcoming heats as soon as all previous race boats are in or the retrieval boat returns to shore.
- **REGISTRATION DEADLINE CUTOFF is May 31<sup>st</sup>. (Paid entries in hand will get first priority) E-Mail entries will be accepted if received before May 15<sup>th</sup> and payment is received before: May 31<sup>st</sup>.**
- All IMPBA rules apply.
- All Classes will only have **ONE** contestant on any **ONE** frequency. This gives us the ability to build heats based on previous heat results. You must accept collect phone calls about frequency conflicts. Once your entry is received, if there is no conflict, you will own that frequency for all of that classes events.
- IMPBA cards **MUST** to be shown upon driver check-in.
- APBA & NAMBA members welcome with a \$10.00, one time entry fee.  
(please send a copy of your membership card with your entry form)
- All non-DSM transmitters will be impounded and an alternate frequency is required for each boat entered. Your name **MUST** be clearly visible on your radio.
- No motors will be started prior to 8:00 am.
- **US-1 Classes: there will be a 24 boat max limit with the top 5 boats or 20% of class will qualify for the Trophy Trials. Max allowed entries for some classes maybe raised in the weeks before entry cutoff.**
- A minimum of **eight** boats are required by May 31<sup>st</sup> to make the US-1 class. If the class does not fill, it will drop from its running spot and that classes 24 spots will be opened up in other US-1 classes where needed.
- US-1 heats and oval trials will run together on their perspective days. All straightaway trials are scheduled to be on Friday and/or Saturday. If time permits, your straightaway trial may run on your second scheduled heat racing day, after your oval trials are complete. (time and weather permitting)
- You may have a different referee for each class but each Class with have the same assigned referee for all your heats. Final decision will be made by the Host CD. Races maybe recorded.
- We have a no mistake starting line. If the referee sees your boat when the clock hits zero...your over.

### Extra Events

- Minimum 6 boats to make a class with classes limited to 18 Boats)
- Extra Events will run five rounds. (Weather and time permitting).
- RTR: Current IMPBA rules apply.
- Wednesday Night Race: Limited to 21 Nitro or Small electric (Example Aquacraft SV27)
  - Glow sticks will be attached to each buoy on the special course located in front of the pavilion area.
  - Each entry must have a pit man.
  - Each entry will receive one glow stick to attach to your boat.
  - You may add your addition lights, blinkers, (ect.), as long as it does not interfere with other driver's vision.

### Novice Class

- Minimum of 3 boats to make a class.
- Heats will be 5 minute enduro with total complete laps counted..
- Novice drivers only pay for the 22.00 banquet ticket. No other race fees.
- Novice: Must be IMPBA members.  
May race any type of hull, except outrigger.  
Motor size 21.cc and under or small electric.  
Novice Driver may not race in any other class.

### Wednesday Night Dinner

- Dinner under the pavilion with all the fixings.
- Open to all registered drivers and one guest.
- Music, Bon-fire, and The Night Race.
