

## 2011 PMBC Club Racing

DATES: April 17<sup>th</sup>, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, June 12<sup>th</sup> (FP), July 10<sup>th</sup>, August 14<sup>th</sup>, September 4<sup>th</sup> (FP), September 25<sup>th</sup>  
and October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

1. Lake opens at 10:00. Drivers meeting at 10:30 sharp. First heat 11:00 sharp.
2. Audio clock will be used.
3. Five minutes between heats (so be ready)
4. Entry: (5.00 dollars per entry for non-club members)(2.00 for members) IMPBA cards will be checked
5. Classes: RTR (any RTR up to 0.18cc Nitro)
  - Sport B Tunnel
  - Super Sport/ Cracker-box
  - Thunder Boat
  - Small Open (A-B Nitro, FE powered: small hull) Example: UL-1, SV27, Zip Rigger
  - Open Cat (Nitro, FE, Gas)
  - Open Mono (Nitro, FE, Gas)
  - Open Hydro/Rigger (Nitro, FE, Gas)
  - D Nitro (any hull type) Example: Sport 40, D Tunnel, D Mono, D Hydro
  - Jersey Skiff
6. Three boats must be entered in a class to run.
7. Half hour break between rounds.
8. Two rounds of racing per day.
9. You MUST report your finish to the CD before exiting the drivers stand or your score will be 0.
10. You must pit for other racers if needed when you're not racing.
11. Be ready to help retrieve boats if needed.
12. Open water before/after the rounds and between.
13. This is a club event, so you will be asked to help setup and tear down.
14. CD's will be Mike Laing, Don Vlcek, Ron Miller, Sharon Vlcek, or maybe you.
15. Race to win, but more importantly race to have fun.
16. Driving etiquette will be expected.
  1. Do not damage to another boat
  2. Respect all drivers regardless of their ability
  3. Pass with caution IMPBA Driving rules apply
  4. Play fair (remember it's just grownups playing with toy boats)
  5. No arguing (CD will make the final decision)
17. Scores will be calculated from your best 12 of the 16 heats. (You can miss two dates or use the extra days to better your 12 heat score).
  1. IMPBA scoring, Racing rules and buoy penalties apply
  2. A no finish will always hurt (so set your goal to finish every race)
  3. Results and scores will be posted on our web site
  4. Awards will be handed out at the PMBC end of the year party
